Home to the current owner for the past 25 years, this equestrian homestead sits on 184 acres in Campbell County, Virginia. The land is gently rolling and perfect for extensive equine training or leisure trail riding. The views are beautiful and there are several building sites on the estate.

Edgewood Farms was the first settlement in Campbell County, Virginia. The original home was built by Colonel Jeremiah Early of the Virginia Militia in 1758. Following a fire, the home was rebuilt in 1988 on the foundation of the old house using materials salvaged from the original home. Today, the home gracefully retains the feel and look of the era. Many doors are original, along with mantels and much of the brick was used in the rebuilding process.
